#### **Our Promise:**

T.O.U.C.H. maintains the policy that no equipment we process will end up in a landfill. All assets will go back into the production stream as raw materials, through the use of refineries and processing plants. This process closes the end-of-life-loop.

## **Facts on Recycling:**

The average lifespan for a common PC is estimated to be three to five years. Every year, 20 to 50 million metric tons of e-waste is generated worldwide. Electronics are the fastest growing portion of America's trash. More then 3.2 million tons of electronic waste is dumped in U.S. landfills each year.
